Additional turn information in brackets eg.

- RIGHT (SO) – the change from one road to another being a RIGHT turn but overall direction is (Straight On).
- RIGHT (2ex) – RIGHT taking 2nd exit at roundabout or multi-side road junction.

A few points on \$ and road name/number:

- The passing thru PLACES will be listed in order if present otherwise the top place.
- No '\$' means no/missing/broken sign.
- Road names mentioned if present when no \$ or at tricky junctions.
- 'Name' followed by \$ is a place name rather than direction.
- Also eg. 'No HGV \$' is a navigation aid.
- Road numbers included even if not visible to aid reference to a map.
